Sweden has been free from high pathogenicity avian influenza (HPAI) for the past 28 days following a stamping out policy in accordance with Article 10.4.6 of WOAHA Terrestrial Animal Health Code. 3. The eggs are unfertilized and derived from layer flocks kept in a farm accredited for the import of eggs by Singapore Food Agency. 4. The farm where the eggs originate has been tested and found to be free from <i>Salmonella</i> Enteritidis, and no case of Newcastle disease has been diagnosed on the farm for the last three (3) months prior to export. 5. The eggs have a fully developed shell and were clean, fresh and fit for human consumption. 6. The eggs have been handled and packed in appropriately sanitised packaging materials and containers in a hygienic manner. 7. The eggs have not been added with additives and/or colouring matters injurious to health.
